Uninterruptible Power Supply for the camera



Manual

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What's in the case?

1x mobile UPS

1x 1.4m cable to connect the mobile UPS to a cars cigarette lighter socket or a 12 Volt socket

Features

- Connects to the cars cigarette lighter socket
- Connects to the cars 12 Volt socket (e.g. for cooling boxes)
- Works with the Battery Monitor cable
- Works with the cameras power cable.
- Reliably powers the camera all day long, every day
- Powers the camera for up to about 10 minutes when disconnected accidentally
- Loud alarm beeper and red light on disconnect.
- Just reconnect it to continue recording without interruption
- No lugging large and heavy batteries around anymore
- No empty batteries stopping you anymore
- 1.4 m cable
- Weight: 0.9 kg
- Size: 20 cm x 9 cm x 6 cm

This Manual

This manual covers aspects specific to the mobiel UPS only.

You should already be familiar with the Camera and the Remote Control.

Cabling

First connect all other cables, incl. the antenna and ODB2 adapter cable.

Plug the 1.4 m cable into the mobile UPS.

Connect it to the cigarette lighter socket.

The LED indicates it gets power from the car. If the LED is not on, make sure the car actually provides power. E.g. start the car's engine.

Plug the camera's power cable into the Battery Monitor cable.

The plug the Battery Monitor cable into the mobile UPS.

The camera starts up as usual.

That's it.

How it Works

When the power from the car is disconnected, the mobile UPS starts to beep and the red light comes on.

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The mobile UPS continues to power the camera for up to 10 minutes. Just plug it back in.

There is no additional notification when the mobile UPS runs out of power itself. It just shuts down.

While this does not damage the camera, it should be avoided.

If you can not restore the power supply to the mobile UPS in time: Stop recording and disconnect the camera yourself.
